## SIZE

Width: approx. 32 cm
Length: approx. 170 cm

## MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Catania Fine, 50 g ball
Approx. $50 \mathrm{~g} \approx 165 \mathrm{~m}$
Col. 01025 (wolke) 3 balls
Col. 01000 (weiß) 2 balls
Col. 01021 (cyclam) 1 ball
Col. 01023 (sonne) 1 ball
Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project. The color names refer to the German names on the sleeves. The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

Size 2,5-3,0 mm circular needle (US size 1-2), 60 cm long 1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

## GAUGE

Garter stitch:
27 st and 46 rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## THE BASICS

## Garter stitch:

RS and WS: knit.

## Brioche edge over 3 st:

The brioche edge is worked over 3 st each at the beginning and end of the row.
In RS: rows: Work the first 3 st and the last 3 st as follows: k1, slip 1 st purlwise with the yarn in front of the work, k1.In WS rows: Work the first 3 st and the last 3 st as follows: slip 1 st purlwise with the yarn in front of the work, k1, slip 1 st purlwise with the yarn in front of the work.

## Increases:

Make 2 st in 1 st: knit front and back increase = 2 st.

# Sunny Striped shawl 

Design: Andrea Schmitz


Recommended Yarn
$\mathbf{M 1}=$ lift the thread between the left and right needles and knit into the back loop

## Fantasy pattern:

R 1 (= RS): * k1, slip 1 st purlwise with the yarn in back of the work, repeat from $\boldsymbol{*}$.
R $\mathbf{2}$ (= WS): * slip 1 st purlwise with the yarn in back of the work, k1, repeat from *.

Decreases: k2tog.

## COLOR AND PATTERN SEQUENCE

NOTE: Work all rows in garter stitch, except for some rows of the fantasy pattern (see instructions).

R 1 to 112: 38 R in Wolke, 2 R in Cyclam, 22 R in Wolke, 2 R in Cyclam, 16 R in Wolke, 2 R in Cyclym, 12 R in Wolke, 2 R in Cyclam, 8 R in Wolke, 2 R in Cyclam 4 R in Wolke, $2 R$ in Cyclam $=112 R$.
R 113 to 144: * $2 R$ in Wolke, $2 R$ in Weiß, $2 R$ in Wolke, 2 R in Cyclam, repeat from $* 3$ times $=32 \mathrm{R}$.
R 145 to 164: 20 R in Wolke $=20 \mathrm{R}$.
R 165 to 204: * 4 R in Weiß, $4 R$ in Sonne, $4 R$ in Cyclam, 4 R in Wolke, repeat from * once, 8 R in Wolke $=40 \mathrm{R}$.
R 205 to 220: * 4 R in Weiß, 2 R in Sonne, repeat from * once, 4 R in Weiß $=16 \mathrm{R}$.
R 221 to 262: $2 R$ in Wolke, $2 R$ in Weiß in fantasy pattern, 4 R in Wolke, 2 R in Weiß in fantasy pattern, 32 R in Wolke $=42 \mathrm{R}$.
R 263 to 316: $8 R$ in Weiß, $8 R$ in Cyclam, $6 R$ in Weiß, 6 R in Cyclam, 4 R in Weiß, 4 R in Cyclam, * 2 R in Weiß, $2 R$ in Cyclam, repeat from *3 times, $2 R$ in Weiß $=54 R$.
R 317 to 366: 50 R in Wolke = 50 R.
R 367 to 390: 6 R in Weiß, 6 R in Sonne, 6 R in Cyclam, 6 R in Weiß = 24 R.
R 391 to 408: 1 R in Weiß, * 2 R in Wolke, 2 R in Weiß, repeat from * 3 times, 1 R in Wolke $=18 \mathrm{R}$.
R 409 to 444: 36 R in Wolke $=36 \mathrm{R}$.
R 445 to 468: 2 R in Weiß, 2 R in Sonne in fantasy pattern, $2 R$ in Weiß, * 4 R in Sonne, 2 R in Weiß, repeat from * 2 times $=24 \mathrm{R}$.

R 469 to 532: 2 R in Wolke, $2 R$ in Weiß, 4 R in Wolke, 2 R in Weiß, 8 R in Wolke, 2 R in Weiß, 16 R in Wolke, 2 R in Weiß, 24 R in Wolke, 2 R in Weiß $=64 \mathrm{R}$.
R 533 to 564: 1 R in Weiß, * $2 R$ in Cyclam, $2 R$ in Weiß, repeat from * 6 times, 2 R in Cyclam, 1 R in Weiß $=32$ R.
R 565 to 588: 4 R in Weiß, 4 R in Wolke, 4 R in Weiß, 4 R in Cyclam, 4 R in Weiß, 4 R in Sonne $=24 \mathrm{R}$.
R 589 to 606: * 2 R in Weiß, 2 R in Wolke, repeat from * once, 2 R in Weiß, 2 R in Wolke in fantasy pattern, $2 R$ in Weiß, 2 R in Wolke, $2 R$ in Weiß in fantasy pattern $=18 \mathrm{R}$.
R 607 to 782: 2 R in Wolke, 2 R in Weiß, repeat from * 43 times = 176 R.
R 783 to 786: 4 R in Wolke $=4 \mathrm{R}$.
Work 786 R once.

## INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: The shawl is started at one point. The increases are made only on one side, at the right edge, until the width of the shawl is reached. Then work without increases. The decreases are made only on one side, at the left edge. The shawl ends with a point.
st purlwise = 5 st.
R 785: k1, slip 1 st purlwise, sk2p (slip 1 knitwise, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over) $=3$ st.
R 786: slip 1 st purlwise, k1, slip 1 st purlwise $=3$ st.
In the next RS-row sk2p the last 3 st.
Cut the yarn and pull through the last st.
Total length $=786 \mathrm{R}$ (= approx. 170 cm ).

## FINISHING

Dampen and block the piece according the measurements; allow to dry.
Weave in all ends at the brioche edge.

Cast on 3 st in Wolke.
First WS-row: slip 1 st purlwise, increase 1 st, slip 1 st purlwise $=4$ st. This row is not counted in the color and pattern sequence.
From here on, knit in the color and pattern sequence, work the increases and decreases as described.
R 1 (= RS): k1, slip 1 st purlwise, increase 1 st, k1 = 5 st.
R $\mathbf{2}$ (= WS): slip 1 st purlwise, k1, slip 1 st purlwise, increase 1 st, slip 1 st purlwise $=6$ st.
R 3 (= RS): brioche edge over 3 st, M1, brioche edge over 3 st = 7 st.
R 4 (= WS): brioche edge over 3 st, k1, brioche edge over 3 st $=7 \mathrm{st}$.
R 5 (= RS): brioche edge over 3 st, increase 1 st, brioche edge over 3 st $=8$ st.
R 6 (= WS): brioche edge over 3 st, k2, brioche edge over 3 st $=8 \mathrm{st}$.
R 7 (= RS): brioche edge over 3 st, increase 1 st, work garter stitch to the last 3 st, brioche edge over 3 st $=1$ increased st.
R 8 (= WS): brioche edge over 3 st, work garter stitch to the last 3 st, brioche edge over 3 st.
R 9 to 166: repeat the 7th and 8th R 79x $=88$ st ( $=$ approx. 32 cm ) after 166 R (= approx. 36 cm ).
R 167 to 620: work 454 R (= approx. 98 cm ) without increases.
R 621 to 782: from now work decreases, work in the RS as follows: brioche edge over 3 st, work to the last 5 st, decrease 1 st, brioche edge over 3 st.
Repeat these decreases $81 \mathrm{x}=7 \mathrm{st}$.
R 783 (= RS): k1, slip 1 st purlwise, sk2p (slip 1 knitwise, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over), slip 1 st purlwise, k1 = 5 st.
R 784 (WS): slip 1 st purlwise, k1, slip 1 st purlwise, k1, slip 1
